Festivals: Harvest, Christmas, Remembrance Day, Diwali, Chinese New Year, Mothering Sunday.

Places of Worship: Pupils will extend their knowledge of Christian places of worship. They should also study a Mosque and a Gurdwara and the important features found there. Children will study types of pilgrimage, and visit Worcester Cathedral as part of this.

Festivals: Christmas, Lent, Easter, Harvest, Remembrance Day, Diwali, Mothering Sunday.
