School Rules

- School uniform must be worn.
- You may provide your child with a mask (to walk to school in) and a named hand gel bottle if you wish. Masks will not be worn in classrooms.
- Parents and carers please be available to collect your child as soon as possible if they show any signs or symptoms of Covid-19
- Attendance at school is compulsory for all pupils.

Staggered start and end to the school day

- This is key to minimise the number of people on our playground at any given time
- Remember to adhere to social distancing as much as possible
- Please do not arrive earlier than your allotted time, we do not want parents and children congregating around school. However, we do understand if you have different start times for your children, it may be necessary to wait in the playground
- Your child will line up for drop off and collection by the appropriate class line
- Ensure that your morning routines are sound and that you arrive to school **on time** and you pick your child up **promptly**. We will be unable to look after children by the office if parents are late
- Staggered times will be reviewed before Easter 2021.
- Please can parents wear a face covering when dropping and collecting your children (unless you are medically exempt).

Lessons and Learning

- Children will be taught the full range of academic subjects, with additional emotional support and Personal Social Health and Emotional education.
- Pupils do not require any equipment – school will provide everything.
- Each child will be allocated a forward facing desk, a chair, textbooks, exercise books and writing/drawing equipment.
- Nursery and reception children will continue their learning in their class bubbles with regular handwashing and cleaning of resources throughout the day.

Around school

- Jesson's will enforce a one-way system around school (where possible)
- Staggered use of toilet areas.
- Break and lunch times will be staggered across school.
- Children will be encouraged to socially distance wherever possible.

School Meals and Packed Lunch

- School dinners and packed lunches will be eaten in their classroom
- You may provide your child with a packed lunch, or they can choose from our school meals menu
- If you are entitled to Universal Free School Meals in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, or Free School Meals, these will be available as usual.
- For nursery children, please provide them with a packed lunch.

PE Days

- Children will have an allocated day for PE and on those days children can still wear their PE kit all day.
